Ingenuity collaborates with CPS schools, cultural organizations, teaching artists, arts investors, and civic leaders to institutionalize the arts throughout CPS schools. This ecosystem is transforming CPS schools and advancing the next generation of Chicago's creative leaders.

Since 2011, Ingenuity has driven the most arts education progress in CPS history! Today, 102,000 more CPS students have consistent access to the arts every year, and nearly 60% of schools offer high-quality arts education programs to 65% of the student population.
