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TRAUMA-INFORMED & HEALING-CENTERED PRACTICE TRAINING PROGRAM

This year has challenged us to more fully explore the ways in which arts can be a tool for recovery from crisis – whether as a healing practice, a spark for protest and change, or an antidote to the challenges students, teachers, and schools have faced in 2020. Now more than ever, we must universally embrace trauma-informed practice and an equity mindset in our teaching practices and operations so we are ready to meet students where they are today.

We've partnered with expert practitioners from [Chicago Growth Mindset](#), the [Illinois ACEs Response Collaborative](#), the [Illinois Collaboration on Youth](#) and the [Institute for Therapy Through the Arts](#) to develop the Trauma-Informed & Healing-Centered Training Program, a multi-month program designed to aid our sector in understanding, implementing, and advancing healing-centered and trauma-informed principles and competencies within organizational and programmatic practice. HISTORICAL & COMMUNITY TRAUMA

This pre-recorded training discusses the background of historical and community trauma, as well as how these traumas can impact health outcomes just as strongly as individual experiences. It also tracks how these traumas have become integrated into the systems that direct much of our lives – education, housing, healthcare, and the criminal-legal system – and are perpetuated through implicit biases and explicit prejudices.
